## Post-Convening Survey Methodology

Using Survey Monkey Enterprise, the convening organizer and participants of the convening “Accelerating the End of Extreme Poverty: A Roadmap for Regional Cooperation in the Face of Increasing Climate Vulnerability” which took place between September 2 – 6, 2024, at the Bellagio Center’s Sfondrata facility, were surveyed to better understand their overall convening experience, points of learning, as well as their experience at the Bellagio Center itself.

**Sampling:** Survey sent to all 22 participants

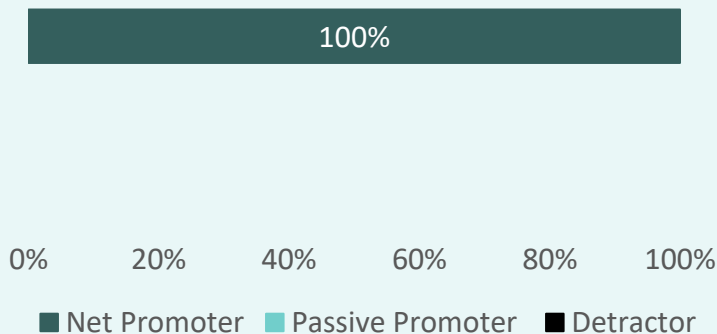
**Responses received:** 10

# Satisfaction & Experience Highlights

This convening's Net Promoter Score is **100** out of 100.



78% of survey respondents reported that they were very satisfied by the opportunities provided for their own unique contributions to convening discussions.

67% reported being very satisfied with the quality of the convening's content, the balance between presentations and discussions, as well as the representation of voices and perspectives present to help shape the objective of the convening.

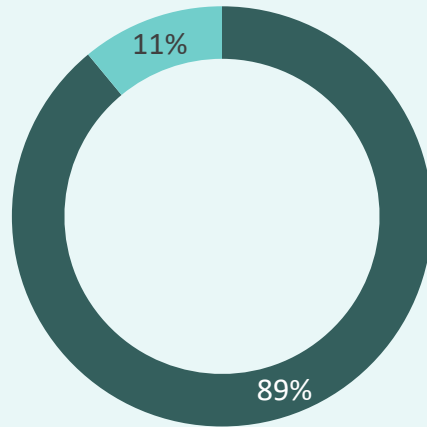

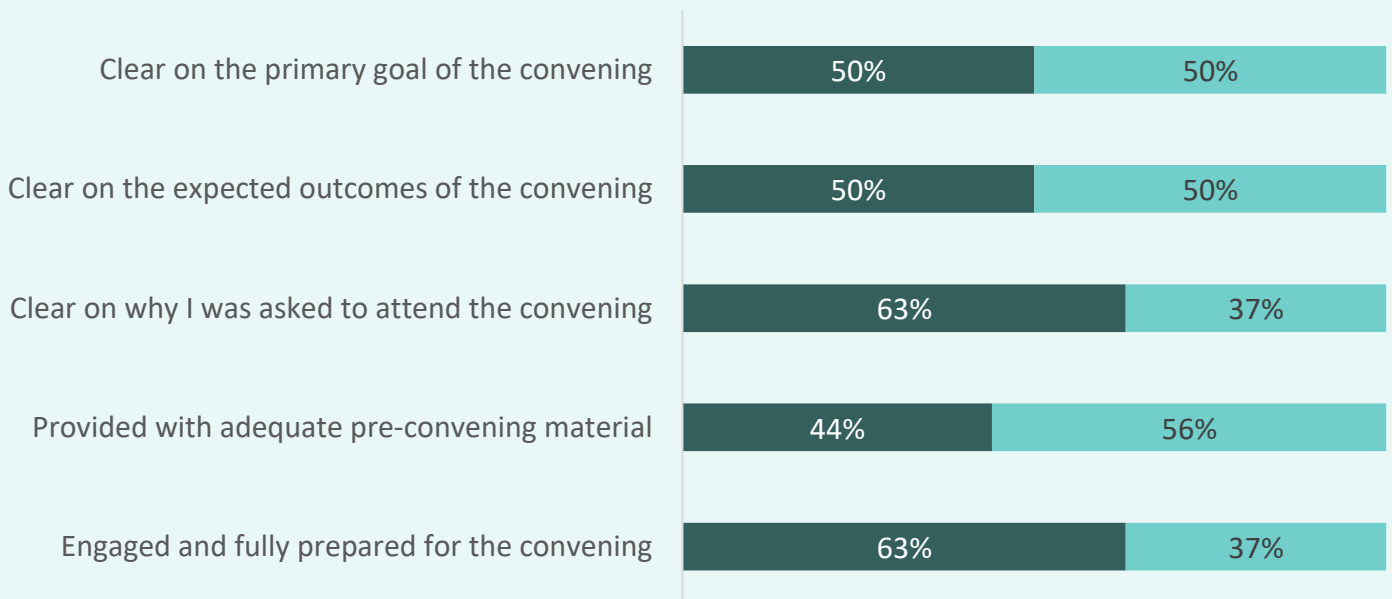

■ Strongly agree ■ Somewhat agree ■ Somewhat disagree ■ Strongly disagree

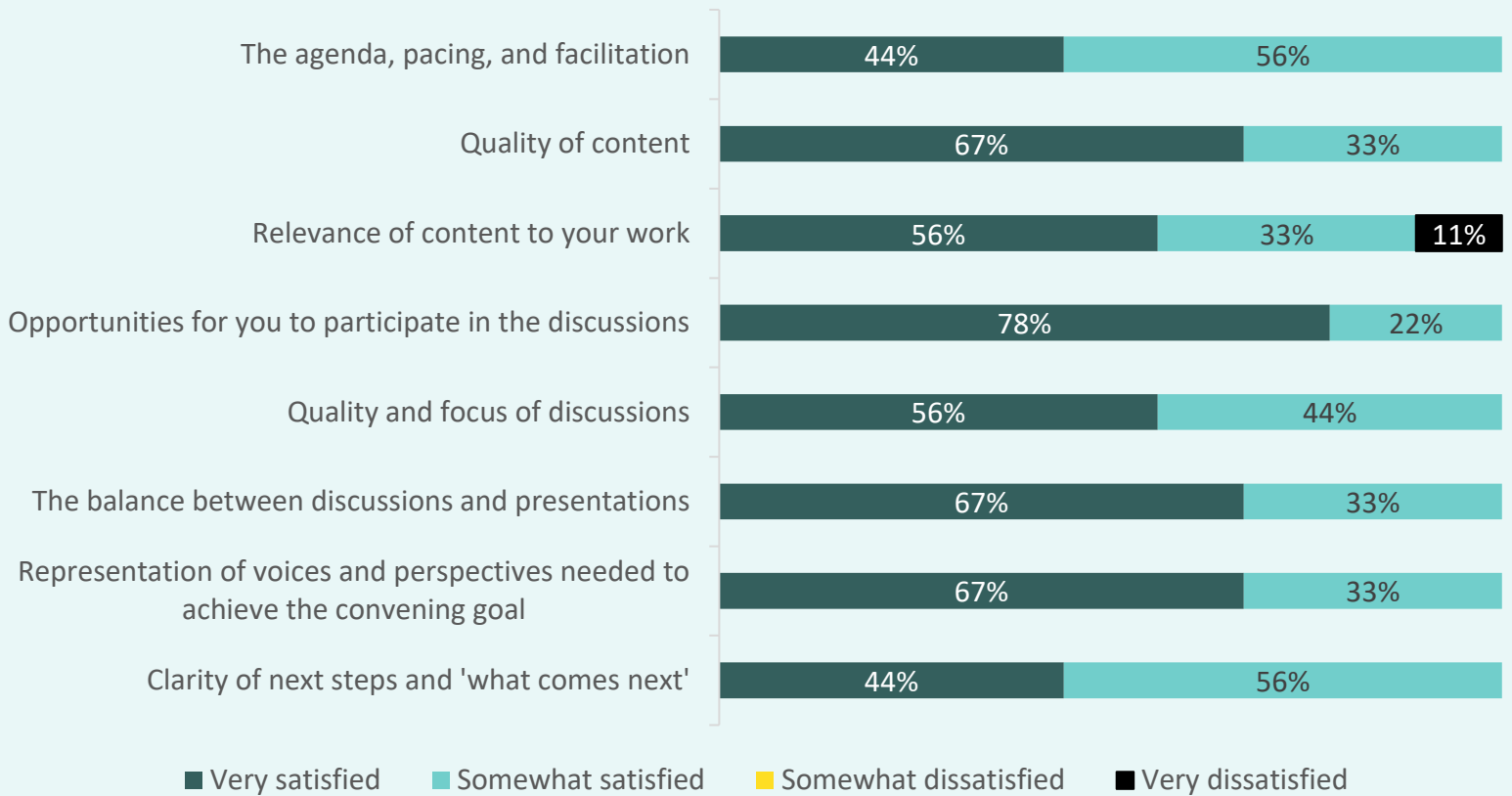

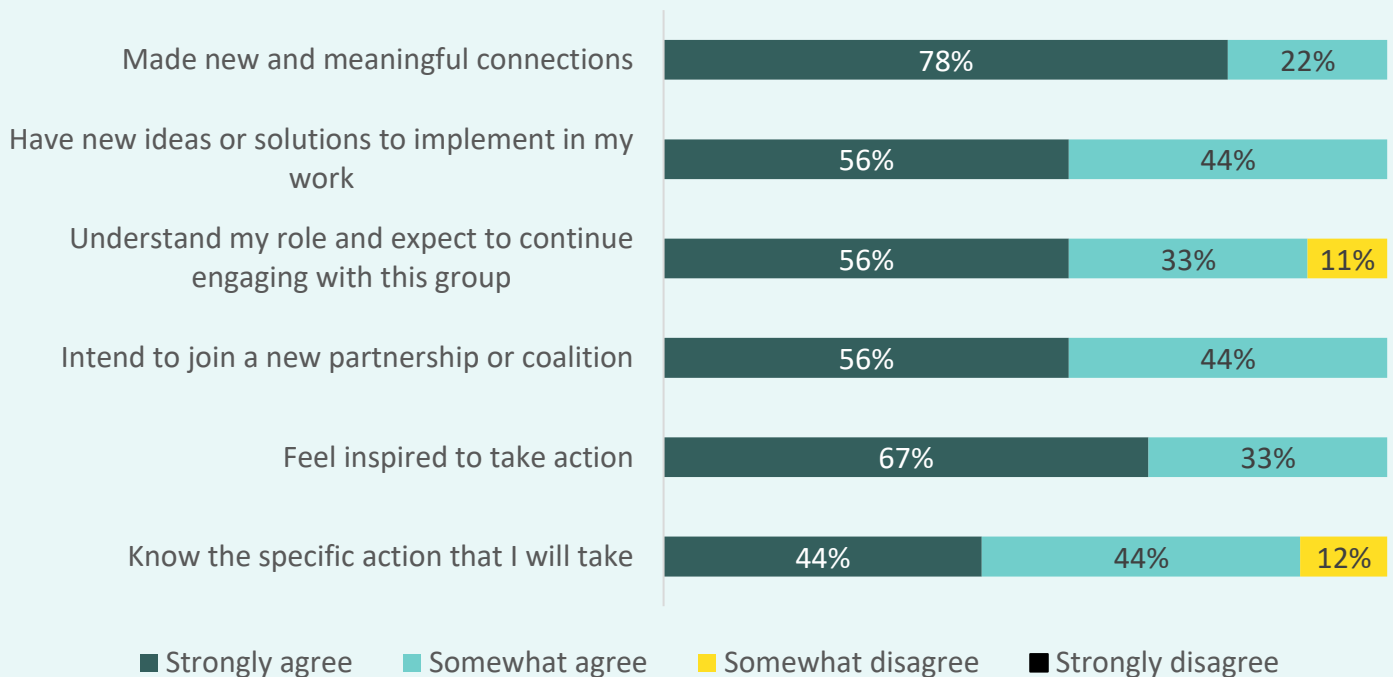

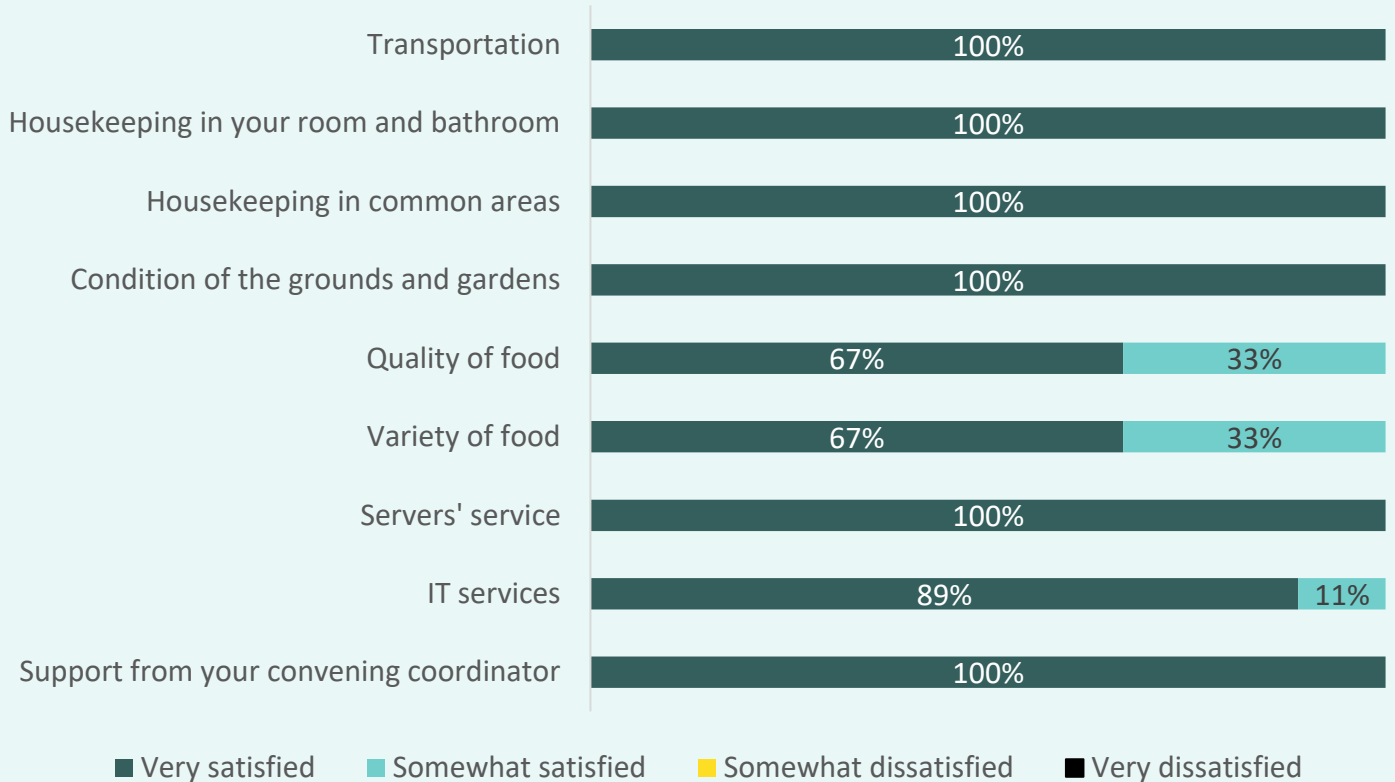
